

## Be a Member of the Bargaining Team

We will be bargaining for a new contract next year. MAPE members will be electing the rank and file members of the bargaining team during the annual MAPE Executive Board elections. The elections begin Monday, **November 6, 2017 when the nomination petitions are due in the MAPE office, by 5:30PM**. Ballots will be out by the week ending Friday, November 17, 2017.

The Bargaining Committee is comprised of rank and file MAPE members and our Executive Director Rollie Katz. We anticipate we will start bargaining in January and will continue until we complete negotiations. Generally, bargaining sessions are held once a week, though some times more frequently. Bargaining team members are given release time to attend bargaining during their work hours.

The Bargaining negotiates our contracts with the County. Union members who serve on the committee play a very important role in our union.

The MAPE bargaining units have the following number of rank and file negotiators:

All you have to do to be on the ballot is submit a completed copy of the petition with qualified signatures and your name will be placed on the ballot. You may also submit a candidate statement of no more than 200 words to the MAPE office at 16 Mitchell Blvd., San Rafael with the petition. Petitions are due by **5:30PM, Monday, November 6, 2017**.
